







Call for applications SCHOLARSHIP TO ATTEND THE INTERNATIONAL JUSTICE AND VICTIMS' RIGHTS SUMMER SCHOOL

PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Canadian Partnership for International Justice is offering four scholarships to graduate students from developing countries and countries in transition 1 to attend the International Justice and Victims' Rights Summer School2, to be held virtually at the Montreal Centre for International Studies, University of Montreal (CÉRIUM), May 24 to June 11, 2021. This scholarship will be used to pay students' tuition.

APPLICATION

Please send a file containing:

- A short CV³, including the list of academic and professional achievements (e.g. education, scholarships, publications, presentations at conferences);
- A letter of motivation specifying your research interests and justifying the benefit of participating in the summer school for the advancement of your project:
- A copy of the grades obtained in your current program;
- A proof of current enrolment in a postsecondary institution.

The school is bilingual (French-English). Students are expected to be fluent in French or English and to have at least a passive understanding of the other language.

Complete files must be sent by email to gaelle.foucault@umontreal.ca. The deadline to receive applications is **Monday**. **March 29**. **2021** at 5:00 PM (Montreal Time). Files must be sent as a single file in PDF format. Only complete files will be considered.
